BDPA Atlanta's STEM program is open to any student interested in advancing their technology skills (novice to master).

SITES

The Student Information Technology Education and Scholarship (S.I.T.E.S) program introduces minority middle school/high school students to the field of Information Technology through training classes and seminars. In addition to technical training, participating students are able to acquire important business and life skills such as public speaking, creating presentations, goal setting, team building and time management.

The S.I.T.E.S program encourages students to learn and participate in the Information Technology field. This program has grown extensively over the years and is the umbrella for several educational programs dedicated to developing students in the field of Information Technology. These programs include:

- HSCC – High School Computer Competition
- YTC – Youth Technology Camp
- ACE – Advance Computer Education
- IT Showcase

HSCC students learn how to develop web applications using CSS, HTML, JavaScript, PHP, Python, and MySQL.

Our MAC (Mobile Application Competition) students develop iOS or Android mobile applications using React Native.
